- Agree to ask for help from the teacher and family if they are having trouble doing their work.

In the Classroom

- Teachers will work to build a relationship with every family in their class and follow the Soar With 4, Kind Campus and Character Strong programs.
- Teachers and staff will keep families informed of students' progress and needs in each subject on a quarterly basis and ensure each student gets the help he/she needs with the use of an Intervention Plan (MTSS) if needed.
- Teachers will send home learning materials and homework assignments as needed.
- Teachers will consult with the Counselor, MTSS Facilitator, Family Liaison and/or Principal when special needs or concerns arise. Howell will NOT tolerate Bullying. Students must inform an adult if an issue comes up so that it can be addressed.
- Teachers and staff will offer flexible times to meet with parents/families when needed so as to provide reasonable access to staff. Virtually, via phone, text, email and or in-person.

At Home

- Adults will bring their children on time to school every day and do their best to schedule appointments outside of school time.
- The adult at home will call the attendance office if their child is ill and agrees
 to come in to the office to sign them in if
 they are late to school. NO DROP OFFS
 ALLOWED.
- The family will always pick-up children on time everyday or let the office know ASAP when running late.
- The family agrees to check student homework folders and monitor their child's progress and let the teacher know if they notice problems or concerns.
- Adults will use the materials the school sends home each week to help their child as needed and help the child see how their academics relate to the pursuit of their interests and goals and in developing life skills.
- Adults will model kindness and help to encourage SOAR with 4 Behaviors.
