We will strive to develop relationships with all families and students. The school will provide Open House, Parent Meetings, Meet & Greets, school tours, and various academic workshops & classes. There will be informal gatherings to help build community through 'Family Nights' and classes. Howell also offers Family Resource support in Rm 3. TUSD now has Family Resource Centers open and ready to help all families in need. Info. is in the parent rack by office or Rm 3.

Communicating Effectively

We will provide timely & informative school communication through emails, phone calls, texts, calendars, school/teacher/parent compacts, newsletters, flyers, and daily announcements. All information is available in both English and Spanish to meet the needs of our diverse population. For those parents who are not proficient in either English or Spanish, the school will make every effort to provide an interpreter.

Speaking Up For Every Student

We will help to develop family and student capacity as effective advocates. We will provide information on student discipline, Students Rights & Responsibilities, McKinney-Vento Homeless support, the complaint process, Drop Out Prevention IEP's & 504's - services for Exceptional Ed & Health Impairment issues— as well as advocacy workshops for parents. **Zero tolerance on bullying—students need to speak up, let an adult know.**

Supporting Student Success

We will help to develop families abilities to seek appropriate academic resources. Through Parent teacher conferences and review of the Compact, parents are included in the educational goals for their child. Teachers & support staff will provide literacy & math experances, learning at home activities, grade level workshops re: State Testing, Annual Yearly Progress, Parental Access, Arizona College and Career Readiness Standards, and testing data interpretation.



Sharing Power & Responsibility

We will work to develop parent leadership through decision making. Parents will take part in the annual review of the Parent Policy and Compact. We will continue to share decision making through Site Council meetings - everyone is welcome and encouraged to Attend.
